

1. What are the dates of the 2026 Triple Play Convention?

December 7-10, 2026

2. Where can I submit my application?

3. Do speakers receive compensation?

Speaker compensation is considered on a case-by-case basis based on a variety of factors which include some of the following: speaker expertise, how many courses the speaker has been selected to instruct during the convention and the 2026 budget.

4. What are the topics and categories being solicited?

Appraisal, Brokerage Management, Commercial, Environmental and Contamination Issues, Implicit Bias and Cultural Competency, Legal and Ethics, Property Management, Professional Development, Sales and Marketing, and Social Media and Technology.

5. What is the recommended format and length for conference sessions?

Individual speakers and a small panel (maximum 3-person panel) will be considered for continuing education and non-continuing education sessions. All classes are taught in theater style classrooms. Session length varies from 1-3 hours with designation courses as the exception.

6. If I have previously presented at Triple Play, can, or should I resubmit the same topics for instruction?

The Tri-State Committee seeks new and relevant real estate topic submissions each year. If you have previously spoken at Triple Play, there is a record of your previous topics. If the committee would like a repeat of the previous topic staff will be directed to contact you for an updated version of the selected.

7. What is the Tri-State Committee considering during the application review process?

- Clear and concise description of the course content and objectives.
- Continuing education course submissions are reviewed to determine if the course content submitted is eligible for credits in NJ, NY and PA. Courses submitted for consideration of continuing education credits must upload a timed outline. Please use the following example when submitting a course outline: realtorstripleplay.com/outline-template.

8. When will speakers be notified of the selection process?

- Applying to be a speaker does not guarantee acceptance.
- Previously selected speakers are not guaranteed annual acceptance as a speaker.
- The deadline to submit proposals is March 31, 2026. After that date the review process will take place at the beginning of May and all applicants will be notified no later than mid-June.
- All selected speakers will be provided with a speaker agreement which includes complimentary registration for the convention. Special ticketed events are not included in the complimentary registration.

9. Will there be a keynote speaker?

The members of the Tri-State Committee will discuss the applicants who have submitted keynote presentation topics and determine on an annual basis if they wish to select a Keynote Speaker for the current year.
